FAQ's

Q: How long does RadVision take to be installed?

A: Our goal is to have RadVision installed within one to two weeks from the time of your request. It takes approximately 30 minutes to load the program on each computer.

Q: What are the requirements for RadVision?

A: A high speed internet connection and Windows XP or 2000 is required for RadVision to perform properly. For your convenience, RadVision can be installed on desk tops, laptops, and tablets.

Q: Is RadVision training given to new users?

A: Yes, our RadVision Specialist(s) will provide a tutorial on how to use the system to review your patient images and reports. A user guide with instructions on how to manipulate the images, open and close the system, and utilize tools will also be left for any future questions.

Q: What does RadVision include?

A: RadVision provides complete radiology data in one spot. Patient images, final reports, preliminary reports, and previous reports are available. Also included are prior studies from Radiology Ltd.

Q: Who receives a username and password?

A: All Providers and office staff can receive usernames and passwords for RadVision. Those include: MDs, DOs, DCs, PAs, NPs, RNs, MAs, Front Office, Medical Records, Billing, etc.

Q: Will other software on my computer be affected by RadVision?

A: No, other software on your computer should not be affected by the installation of RadVision. RadVision is installed using a VPN (Virtual Private Network) which works independently from any other software that may be running at the same time.

Q: Will RadVision slow my computer down?

A: RadVision should not conflict with the speed of any of your computer programs.

Q: How much does RadVision cost?

A: It is absolutely free!

Q: Can I print or burn CD's from RadVision?

A: Printing from RadVision is easy; just use the print icon in the tool bar or just click the CD icon to burn your patient's images.
