What is Radiology Ltd. Clinical Review?

The new Clinical Review Team was created as a resource for referring offices, patients, and our technologists and schedulers. This process is an extension of our Centralized Scheduling Department and offers our schedulers immediate access to imaging experts. Members of the Clinical Review Team are comprised of several radiologic technologists who are experts in all imaging modalities.

What do they do?

The Clinical Review Team can help you with all of your imaging questions. They are responsible for reviewing orders for exams, clinical indications and special instructions in conjunction with our imaging protocols. They will review the patient schedule in advance to ensure everything is in order for the patient's exam.

The Clinical Review Team will also:

- Review insurance authorizations that have been obtained and confirm that they coincide with the orders and the scheduled exam
- Ensure patients are scheduled in the most appropriate machine to optimize their exam results
- Identify special instructions on the orders and notify Radiology Ltd. staff
- Request necessary labs required for the exam
- Contact referring offices with any issues regarding orders to help eliminate redundant and excessive phone calls

How does this benefit patients and providers?

The Clinical Review Team is not just an internal resource. It offers many benefits for patients and referring providers by:

- Reducing redundant phone calls to referring offices
- Assisting the referring providers with scheduling and exam questions
