About Our Interventional Radiology Services

However, there are some interventional procedures that require a hospital setting to ensure patient safety and exam effectiveness. These hospital-based procedures are performed at Tucson Medical Center or St. Joseph's Hospital by one of our board-certified interventional radiologists.

In order to expedite the scheduling process for hospital-based procedures we recommend that you:

- Use the appropriate hospital scheduling form which is different from the Radiology Ltd. Interventional Services scheduling form.
- Schedule the exam directly through the scheduling department of the designated hospital.
- Utilize the Radiology Ltd. scheduling department as a resource if you need assistance with ordering hospital-based interventional procedures.
